

Build a Campfire

Tools of the trade

One bag of fire starter, three logs, a box of matches

Fun fact about campfires

Colors can tell you a lot about the temperature of the fire. Red signals the cooler parts of the fire, while the bluish-white flames are where the fire is hottest.

Reward for challenge

Heat and light

Instructions

1. Gather your materials: fire starter, four or five logs, and matches or a lighter.
2. Arrange two medium-sized logs side-by-side (about a foot apart) and then lay two or three smaller logs across the top. Your structure should resemble tic-tac-toe.
3. Spread the fire starter on the ground in the center of the logs.
4. Light the fire starter.
5. Blow gently as necessary to fuel the flame.
